



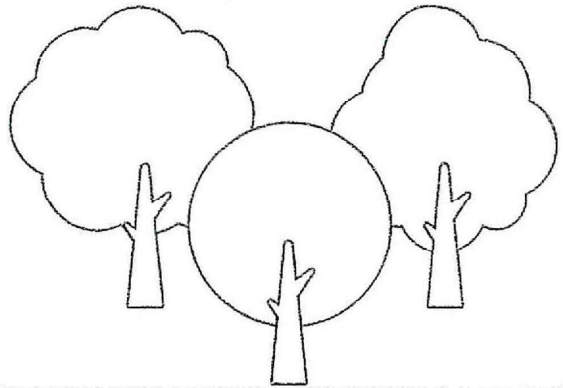

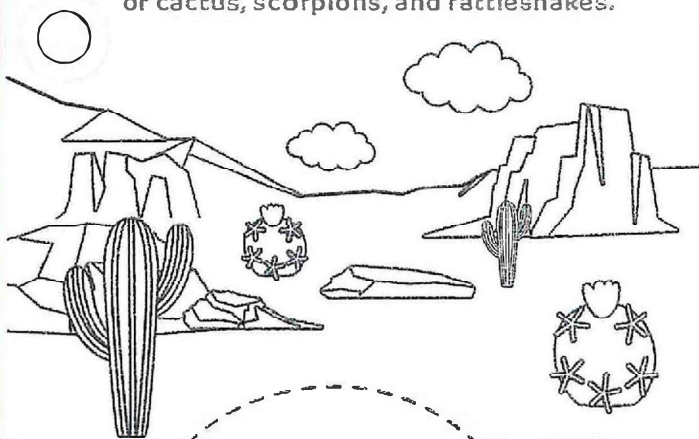
Mexico's official name is United Mexican States



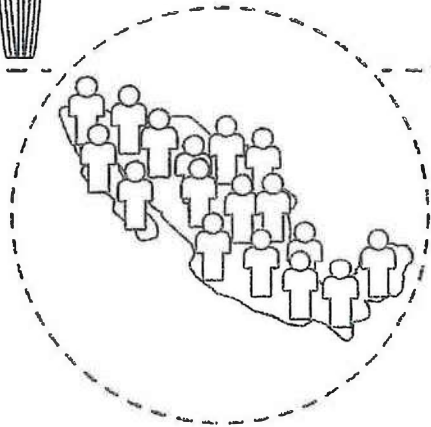
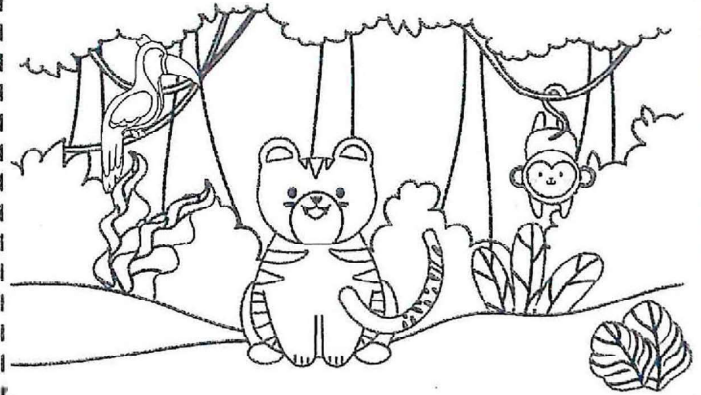
Very few countries have as many plant and animal species as Mexico does.



The northern part of Mexico is a desert, with lots of cactus, scorpions, and rattlesnakes.

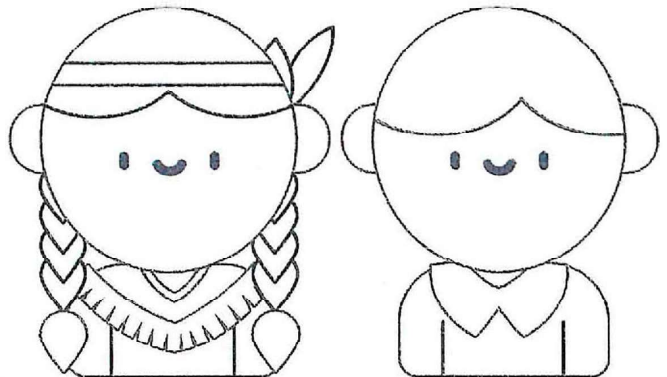


The south of Mexico is a tropical rain forest with many different animals living there.

Many Mexicans have a mix of Native American and Spanish blood.

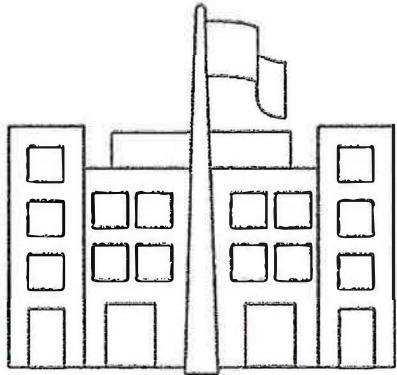




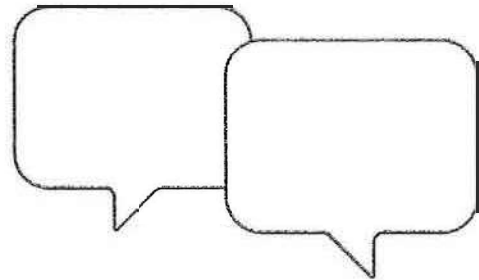

Mexico's capital is Mexico city, which has 17 million inhabitants.



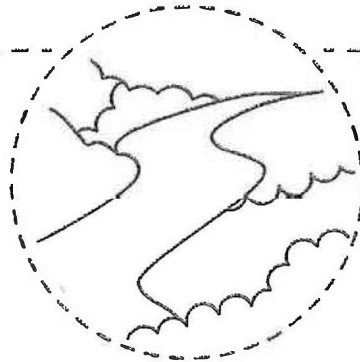
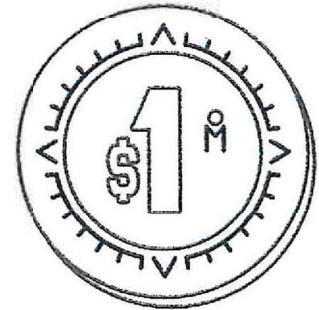
Spanish is the most spoken language, but there are other native languages such as Nahuatl, Yucatec Maya, Mixtec, among others.
