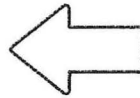
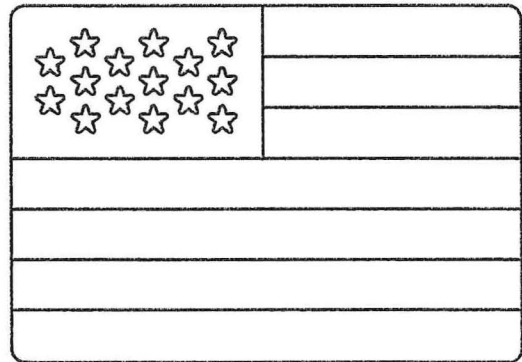
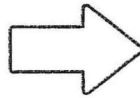
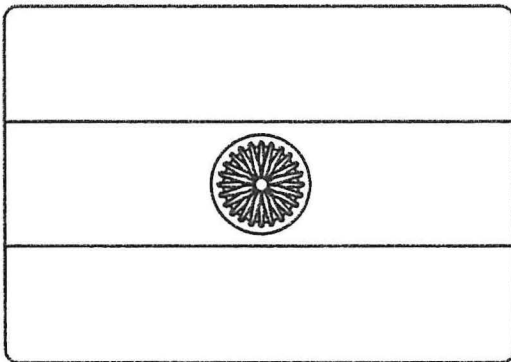
India, officially the Republic of India, is a country in the Asian continent. It is the seventh-largest country by area, the second most populated country, and the largest democracy in the world.



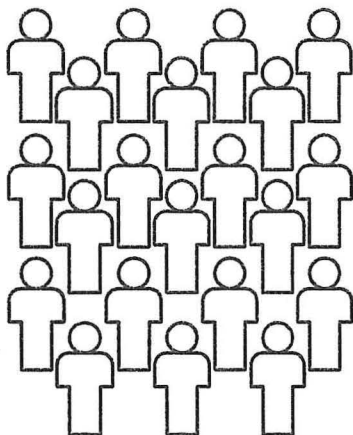
The capital of India is New Delhi.

India's population is 1.4 billion, with 705 officially recognized ethnic groups.



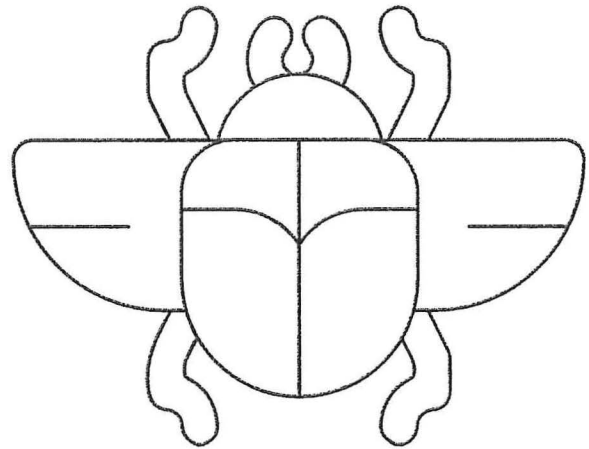

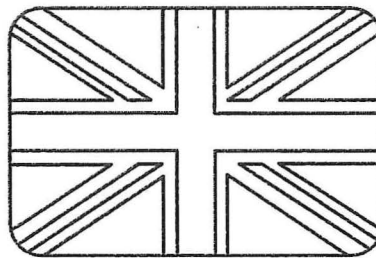
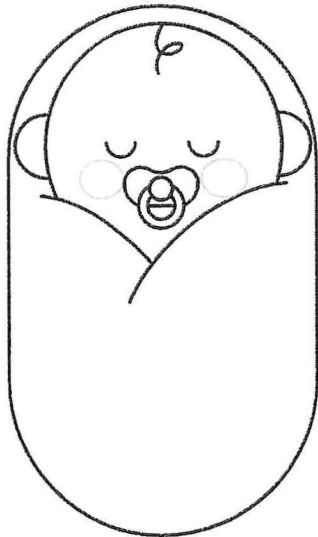

India has a large variety of fauna: 92,037 animal species, of which insects alone include 61,375 species.



India's birth rate has declined by 20% over the last decade.



The British Raj was the British rule on the Indian subcontinent and lasted from 1858 to 1947.

The name 'India' is derived initially from the Sindhu (Indus River)'s name and has been used in Greek since the 5th century BCE.



Although India has no national language, the country's official language is Hindi in Devanagari script. 10% of the Indian population speaks English.
